Annual Report 2020-21

It gives me immense pleasure to share the Annual Report of 2020-2021 with you. This year was not a normal school year. But despite all the odds, we were successful in most of our endeavours. Apart from preparing the children to qualify for the academic demands, we have been successful in making them all rounder's and face the challenges of the competitive world.

This report is a blueprint of the school's progress in terms of achievements and activities held during this year.

ACADEMICS: We are proud to share that 2020-2021 batch of Grade XII brought laurels for the school by their outstanding results.

Class XII: Ridhima of Non-Medical secured 97.6% and emerged as the overall topper of the school. Rasleen Kaur Sandhu of Non-Medical scored 96.8% and became the topper of Non-Medical Stream. Kanwar Nishan Singh of Non-Medical secured 95%. In Medical Stream, Stuti secured 97.2% and Deepnoor Kaur scored 96.6%.

Mantoz Kaur of Commerce secured 96.4% and became the topper of Commerce Stream in the school. Navya of Commerce scored 95.6% and Harnoor Kaur of Commerce scored 95%.

Anshika Gupta became the Humanities Topper by scoring 95.6%.

Class X: Kavish Kumar of Peace Public brought laurels to the school by bagging the topper position with 96.8% in school in the Class X Board Examination. Lovish Gupta secured the second position by scoring 94.8% and Mansi Bansal stood third with 94.6%. It is indeed a matter of great pride that 100% students passed the exams.

Another feather in the cap is the Certificate of Merit awarded by CBSE to Jasmine Kaur Multani and Ritvik Goyal for their outstanding result in the Board Examination in March 2020. The certificate holds a great significance as it is awarded by CBSE to students with exemplary performance in the field of academics.

SPORTS: Sports and physical fitness manifest an important part in our curriculum. Our students actively participated at District, State, National and International Levels and won accolades for the school.

Our students participated in the 6th National Karate Championship in Meerut on December 26, 2021 and won laurels for the school.

Akshay Jhanjhi and Parmeet Singh Grewal won silver and bronze medals at the prestigious 12th WUKF European Karate Championship in December 2021.

In the Open Inter-State Karate Championship organized by the Punjab Karate Shakotan Organisation our school won one gold, two silver and one bronze.

In the U-12 and U-19 Open District Athletic Meet, Niyati Parmar and Tajveer Singh garnered appreciation for the school by winning the first prize.

Vishavjeet Kaur Grewal won two silver medals in the 1st Roller Skating Championship organized by the Ludhiana Roller Skating Club. She made it to the 33rd Punjab Roller Skating State Level Competition. This does not put an end to her long string of achievements. In the 24th District Roller Skating Championship Ludhiana, she won two gold and one silver.

In the previous session our students participated in numerous events covering a wide range of talent areas and won several prizes.

Rasleen Kaur Sandhu emerged as the indubitable winner in a debate conducted by Entab Campus Care.

Praneel Tangri and Gurmandeep Singh secured the second position in WR-07: App Design Competition. Whizkid Praneel also secured the second position in the prestigious World Skills Junior 2021 Competition.

To promote the competitive spirit and to unleash the latent talent of the students a number of activities and competitions were organized during the session. Competitions like Fancy Dress, Recitation, Drawing, and Mono Action were conducted during the course of the year.

Another value addition to the school is the new building which has been constructed solely for vocational education. We firmly believe that vocational training permits students to gain practical experience and this is essential to prepare world class students, so that they can keep pace with the emerging trends.

All this progress has been possible with the concerted efforts of our highly qualified and dedicated faculty who have contributed in their own capacity.
